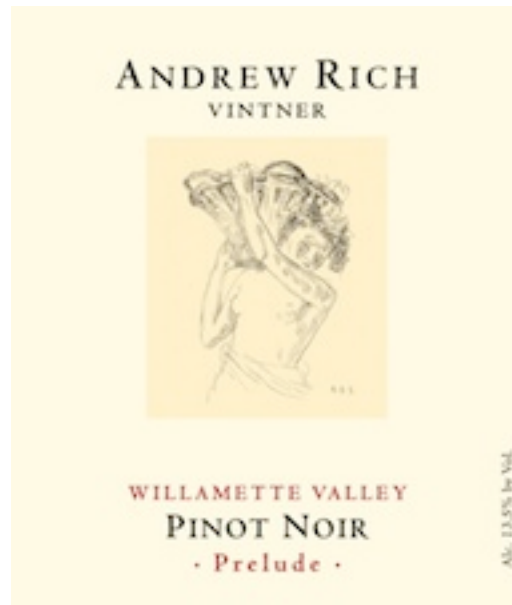


ANDREW RICH WINES

2011 Pinot Noir Prelude

Our first release from the latest vintage on record may be noticeably lower in alcohol but it lacks not at all in body, with an uncanny marriage of suppleness and lift. The damp earth, strawberry, and pepper of the nose carry over to the palate, and even at this early stage the tannins seem soft. There is a mouth-watering deliciousness here that invites early drinking, but I expect this to continue to flesh out over the next year. [AR 5/13]
