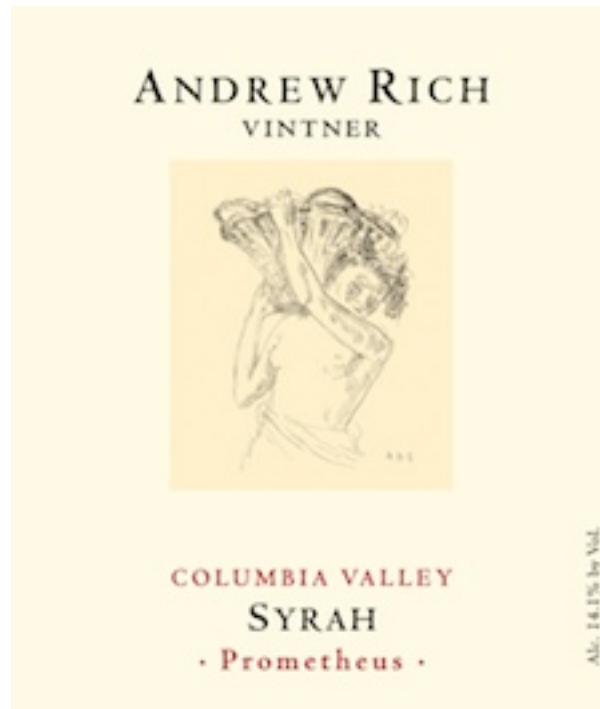


# ANDREW RICH WINES

## 2011 Syrah Prometheus

A blend of our top two Syrah vineyards; Red Willow had Syrah planted in 1986, making it the oldest in the Columbia Valley, and Ciel Du Cheval was planted a decade ago with cuttings from the famed Ch. Beaucastel vineyard in Chateauf-du-Pape. The wine shows great precision on a medium-bodied frame. With flavors of blueberry and licorice and a suave, singing mouth feel (that is, it has richness *and* good acidity), it can easily slumber in your cellar for half a decade or more and can be enjoyed now with rich and meaty dishes.
