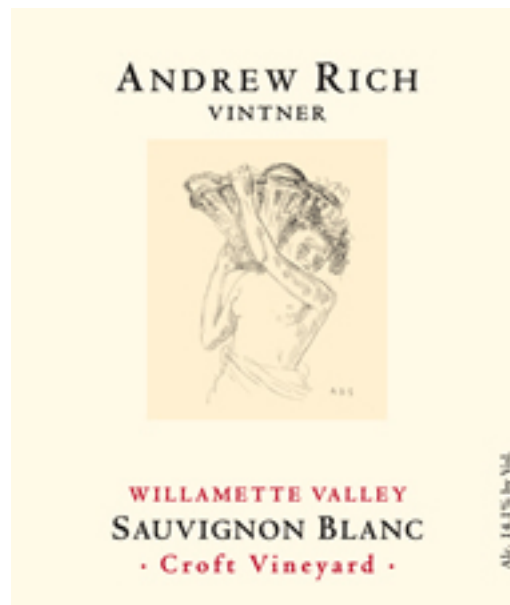


ANDREW RICH WINES

2012 Sauvignon Blanc Croft Vineyard

From a warm vintage, our current release harkens back to Croft Sauvignons of old—perhaps 2006 or 2009. The nose explodes with aromas of passion fruit and gooseberry (and, if you insist, a faint whiff of kitty). The palate is rich (but never ponderous), owing not just to the ripeness of the vintage but to extended time on the lees, thanks to a pokey fermentation. Bottled later than usual, the wine is just now (September 2013) coming together, and makes a lovely aperitif or a superb accompaniment to vegetable dishes and lighter meats.
