## 2013 Pinot Noir Verbatim

Our first Pinot to be released from a two-faced vintage. We went into harvest strategizing on how to handle a hot dry year, but when five inches of rain fell over four days in late September, our plans went out the window. Nonetheless, when farming was meticulous and sorting was ruthless, what resulted were Pinots that are indisputably ripe in character, but on a lighter frame, with vibrant acidity, moderate alcohol, and soft tannins.
